## **TOURNAMENT RULES & FORMAT**

This handicap Doubles Tournament will be sanctioned by the BTBA and the BTBA's General Playing and Tournament Rules will govern this event.

It is open to BTBA & any other national association members who are in good standing. Non-members may play upon payment of a £10 Day Membership to the Local Association.

A provisional ball will be rolled if a dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved immediately. Protests must be lodged verbally with the Tournament Manager at the time of the infraction occuring and confirmed in writing within 72 hours. The Tournament Manager will be Wayne Lester and his decision on all matters shall be final, subject to appeal to the BTBA.

The Tournament will be played as two separate events:

- a) teams with a combined average of 390 or OVER
- b) teams with a combined average UNDER 390

Each event will be scored seperately and will produce it's own Prize Winners.

1st Entry: £40 per bowler (£18.00 lineage, £2 Sanction fee, £4 Expenses & £16.00 Prize Fund)

2nd Entry: £30 per bowler (£18.00 lineage, £2 Expenses & £10.00 Prize Fund)

No competitor will be allowed to smoke or consume alcoholic beverages during play or lane change times. Any bowler whose conduct is deemed as derogatory to the best interest of the sport on and off the lanes, during the entire period of the tournament, may be disqualified from the event and reported to the BTBA.

Whilst bowling in the tournament, competitors must be properly and appropriately dressed for bowling. Shorts, Skirts & Skorts must be longer than the player's fingertips with their arms by their sides. Sleeveless shirts are not acceptable.

#### In the event of a tie, the prize will be split.

All Teams must register at least 30 minutes prior to the squad time. Latecomers will commence scoring at the frame in progress, as determined by the Tournament Manager.

#### The event will be played on an Oil Pattern from the Kegel CHALLENGE series.

If a pin falls over after the strings have started to lift for re-set then that pin must be re-spotted. If a pin falls over before the strings have started to lift for re-set then that pin is ruled to have fallen.

#### Free Fall and String averages are both acceptable for all handicap tournaments

Before, during, and after the event there could be photography, filming or video taken of participants and medal winners by anyone attending the event, either as an official, spectator, parent or guardian. If you (as a participant, parent or guardian) object to this, you must make your objections known to the Tournament Manager prior to the event starting and reasonable adjustments will be made.

### **TOURNAMENT RULES & FORMAT**

Upon registration, each team shall be assigned a lane schedule.

Teams will change lanes after every phase - bowling on 4 different pairs across the event.

9-pin-no-tap means that if a bowler scores 9 on their first shot it is automaticaly upgraded to a strike.

Teams will only get 50% of their handicap during this phase

\*Players must use their highest available League or Tour average over a minimum of 12 games. If no such average is available but they have bowled at least 12 games in Middlesex events in the last year then they may use their "Middlesex Tournament Composite Average". The "Middlesex Tournament Composite Average" is available on the Middlesex website.

"High" average teams will be given a handicap of 75% \* (450 - combined average)

"Low" average teams will be given a handicap of 75% \* (390 - combined average)
